At the January 14, 2019 Board of Education meeting...

- **SPOTLIGHT ON LEARNING- HORIZON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**
- Adam Ebbole and Neil Scannell were in attendance to share about activities and student experiences in physical education. Noodle games and disc golf were two games they shared as these games emphasize life-long recreational activity.
- Approved a resolution authorizing the issuance and sale of \$39,700,000 Bond Anticipation Notes Pursuant to Section 67.12(1)(b), Wisconsin Statutes.
- Approved a resolution authorizing the issuance and establishing parameters for the sale of not to exceed \$39,700,000 General Obligation Refunding Bonds
- Approved the check registers and financial report.
- Approved the following field trip requests:
 - Students to travel to UW-Stout for a Culinary Arts Competition from February 13-14, 2019 as presented.
 - Treble Choir and Varsity Choir students to travel to New York from March 20-24, 2020 as presented.
- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding between Pewaukee School District's Insight and Greendale as presented.
- The Board designated 29 open enrollment seats available at the following grade levels for the 2019-2020 School Year: Four Year Old Kindergarten – 10 Available Seats; Kindergarten – 7 Available Seats; Grade One – 0 Available Seats; Grade Two – 0 Available Seats; Grade Three – 0 Available Seats; Grade Four – 7 Available Seats; Grade Five – 5 Available Seats; Grade Six – 0 Available Seats; Grade Seven – 0 Available Seats; Grade Eight – 0 Available Seats; Grade Nine – 0 Available Seats; Grade Ten – 0 Available Seats; Grade Eleven – 0 Available Seats; Grade Twelve – 0.
- Due to lack of space, the Board did not designate any available seats **for students applying for open enrollment** in the following programs: Preschool Phonology, Early Childhood, Speech and Language Grades EC-12, Learning Disabilities Program K-12, Emotional Behavior Disabilities Programs K-12, and Multi-categorical K-12 for the 2019-2020 school year.
- Approved the 2020-2021 School Year Calendar.
