At the January 8, 2018 Board of Education meeting...

- **SPOTLIGHT ON LEARNING – HORIZON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** – Jodi Swanson introduced Neil Scannell, Physical Education Teacher, who presented an overview of Physical Education and the changes that have happened with the focus on student agency. Neil highlighted the new game students are learning which is Pickle Ball.
- John Stangler, Director of Buildings & Grounds, shared the Five Year Capital Projects Plan.
- Open Enrollment Seat Designations were determined:
 - The Board of Education opened 28 open enrollment seats for the 2018-19 school year in the Pewaukee School District in the following grades:
Four Year Old Kindergarten – 8 Available Seats; Kindergarten – 5 Available Seats; Grade One – 1 Available Seat; Grade Two – 0 Available Seats; Grade Three – 3 Available Seats; Grade Four – 8 Available Seats; Grade Five – 3 Available Seats; Grade Six – 0 Available Seats; Grade Seven – 0 Available Seats; Grade Eight – 0 Available Seats; Grade Nine – 0 Available Seats; Grade Ten – 0 Available Seats; Grade Eleven – 0 Available Seats; Grade Twelve – 0 Available Seats.
 - For students applying for open enrollment, the Board of Education closed the following programs for the 2018-19 school year due to lack of space: Preschool Phonology, Early Childhood, Speech and Language Grades EC-12, Learning Disabilities Program K-12, Emotional Behavior Disabilities Programs K-12, and Multi-categorical K-12.
- Approved a field trip request for students to travel to Lake Superior Regional Robotics Competition from March 7-10, 2018 in Duluth, MN.
- John Gahan shared the Employee Health Plan Options Change for 2018-19.
- Approved the check registers and financial report.
- Approved the resignation of Special Education Teacher Jenny Lichte pending satisfaction of terms in the Teachers Employment Addendum.
- With sadness and much gratitude, the Board accepted the retirement of EC/Speech & Language Teacher Ann Novotny-Gehrke after 34 years of service. The Board also with sadness and much gratitude accepted the retirement of EC/Speech & Language Teacher Cheryl Walden after 25 years of service. Both work at Pewaukee Lake Elementary School.
