At the October 9, 2017 Board of Education meeting...

- **SPOTLIGHT ON LEARNING – SUMMER SCHOOL REPORT-** Anthony Pizzo and Lisa O'Hern shared the summer school report. 1,305 students participated in summer school this past summer.
- Approved the check registers and financial report.
- Received the Assessment Report for the 2016-17 school year shared by Candice Bentley.
